

**PACIFICORP EMPLOYEE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND
SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS**

1. The first consideration will be given to the PacifiCorp fallen employees' family members. Family members described as:
 - a. Legal spouse at time of death until remarried.
 - b. Biological & legally adopted children.

2. The second consideration, if reserves are available, will be given to disabled retired employees' family members. Family members described as:
 - a. Legal spouse at time of disabled retirement
 - b. Biological & legally adopted children.

3. The third consideration will be given to regular full time or retired employee's family members; maximum - 2 qualified scholarships per semester.
 - a. Biological, legally adopted, or step children or grandchildren.

4. Qualifying student status:
 - a. Those who are enrolled as a 12 hour credit – full time - student is preferred.
 - b. Consideration may be given to those who are enrolled as “less than full time” students

5. Grades – must maintain a grade point average of 3.0 – B or higher.
 - a. For the first scholarship awarded, student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and provide a current transcript of grades.
 - b. To qualify for additional scholarships, students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher and provide a current transcript of grades.
 - c. Each quarter or semester application for scholarship must be reapplied for and approved to be considered for additional scholarships.
 - d. If GPA is lower than 3.0, review and consideration may be given to student's work load and schedule.

6. Necessity and income may be considered for qualification.

7. Type of school – must be a credited college or technical trade school.

8. The scholarship will only be offered toward an undergraduate degree or trade certification.

9. The payment of qualified funds will be paid directly to the educational institution.

- a. Special consideration will be given for book allowances and will be paid to the book vendor.
 - b. Any tuition refunds will be returned to the PEMSF.
10. The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application for the payment of qualified funds.
 11. You may be required to submit proof of accreditation for the school you plan to attend.
 12. The scholarship may not be paid if any of the above requirements are not met.
