



PACIFICORP EMPLOYEES
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The first consideration will be given to the PacificCorp fallen employees' family members described as:

- a. Legal spouse at time of death until remarried.
- b. Biological & legally adopted children.

The second consideration will be given to disabled employees' family members described as:

- a. Legal spouse at time of disabled retirement
- b. Biological & legally adopted children.

The third consideration will be given to regular full time or retired employees' family members described as:

- a. Biological, legally adopted children or grandchildren.

Qualifying student status:

- a. Those who are enrolled as 12-hour credit (full-time) students are preferred although consideration may be given to those who are enrolled as less than full-time students.

Grades:

- a. Student should have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and provide a current transcript of grades although consideration may be given to student's work load and schedule.

Necessity and income may be considered for qualification.

Type of school:

- a. The school must be an accredited college or technical trade school.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution.

- a. Special consideration may be given for book allowances if requested by the scholarship recipient. If approved by the Board of Trustees, payment will be made directly to the book vendor.
- b. Any tuition refunds will be returned to the PEMSF.

You may be required to submit proof of accreditation for the school you plan to attend.

The scholarship may not be paid if any of the above requirements are not met.

The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any application, for any reason.
